Checklist to join Girl Troop 58



There is a lot happening when joining Troop 58; below is a helpful checklist to follow to help guide you through the process. As always, please contact any adult leader if you have questions.

- Completed and Signed the BSA Application**
Ensure you put your BSA ID on the application. If unsure of your child's ID, please ask a Scout Leader'
- Scheduled doctor's visit to complete Part C of BSA Health Form**
Some of our trips exceed 72 hours like summer camp or some of our higher adventure trips. This Pre-Participation Physical is important to ensure scouts and adults are capable of attending our longer trips and camps. - Signed Parts A, B and C of BSA Health Form (2 Copies)**
Two copies are required (a photocopy of the original is fine)
Photocopy of your scout's health card (front and back) (2 copies)
Vaccination section filled out or 2 photocopies of the vaccination record or letter attesting no vaccinations
